Right-click it and select Set Desktop Image/Set as wallpaper.iOS: Open the image in Photos. Tap More > Use as wallpaper > choose Set Lock Screen or Set Home Screen. This article explains how to change the desktop background on several operating systems, including Windows, Mac, Linux, iOS, and Android. Locate an image you want to convert into your wallpaper and open it. (By default, it will open in Photos.) Right-click or press and hold to choose Set As > Set as Background or, in earlier versions of Windows, Set as Desktop Background. Alternatively, perform a similar step in File Explorer. Open File Explorer, right-click the image, and select Set as Desktop Background. Another way to change the desktop background in Windows is to open the Customize on Desktop option: right-click the desktop and select Customize. (Or in the Windows 10 menu, go to Settings > Customization > Background.) In Windows 8/7/Vista, access the Control Panel Customization applet. From the Background drop-down menu, select Image. Use a Microsoft image or select Browse to search for a different image on your hard disk. Optionally, adjust, stretch, or fill the screen with the photo, or even tile, center, or span multiple screens. Some versions of Windows offer additional options, such as automatically changing the desktop background after a period of time, which is useful if you don't want to set it with a single background. Windows is not the only operating system that can have your custom desktop background. Below are some instructions for other devices, including how to change it on a wide variety of mobile phones. Right-click a photo on your Mac and choose Set Desktop Image. Use online photos or photos saved on your computer. Another way to the desktop image on a Mac is to right-click a blank area on the desktop and choose the Change Desktop Background option. If you use this method, choose some other wallpapers and have all of them in a cycle on a schedule. If you are using a Linux operating system, such as Ubuntu, right-click the saved photo on your computer and choose the Set as Wallpaper option from the menu. Another option is to right-click on the desktop and go to Change Desktop Background. One way to change on your iPhone, iPad or iPod touch is to first save the image to your phone and then open the Photos app to view it. With the image now open, use the More button at the bottom of the screen to select Use as wallpaper, and then choose Set Lock Screen or Set Home Screen to choose whether to use it on the home screen and/or lock the wallpaper. The images you take with iOS devices will fit perfectly like the wallpaper image on your iPhone, or visit sites that offer images of perfect size for iPhone or iPad wallpaper, such as PhoneWalls.
